

Applicant is responsible for contacting MDIA to advise as to the readiness of the installation for inspection to which this agreement applies.

Final inspection and/or approval may be required by law before electrical current may be introduced for use by occupants. MDIA undertakes to provide inspections until final certification is granted, provided such requests for inspection are made within 120 days from the date of the last inspection.

Upon expiration of 120 days from the date of the most recent inspection, all duties and obligations owed by MDIA shall be deemed completed, and all fees paid by the applicant shall be deemed consideration for services performed. No further inspections shall be undertaken by MDIA without the applicant completing a new application for inspection and payment of all relevant inspection fees. No final certification shall be implied or inferred without issuance of a duly executed certificate by MDIA. Issuance of a final certificate by MDIA will cover only those items and to the extent specifically noted on the certificate.
