The following fees shall be charged for grading and soil excavations:

- 57.7.1. All sites (§71.6): eighty-five dollars (\$85.00) plus twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each one thousand (1,000) cubic yards or portion thereof over one thousand (1,000).

The following fees shall be charged for streets and highways:

57.10.1. New Residential Construction: A one-time flat fee of sixty dollars (\$60.00) shall be charged at the time of building permit application for any and all street openings that may be required prior to or during construction. The Township may also charge for actual cost of inspection by the staff as set forth in Section 57.8 or the Township Engineer on noncontract assignments as set forth in the Township Engineer's rates as certified by the Township Manager. **[Amended 2-6-89 by Ord. No. 1371; 4-5-93 by Ord. No. 1577; 12-5-94 by Ord. No. 1650; 2-6-06 by Ord. No. 1951]**

57.10.2. New Nonresidential Construction (utility companies, etc.)
