NOTIFICATION OF FLOW ISOLATION TESTING

Dear Resident:

The Township of Upper St. Clair will be performing testing in public sanitary sewers that may be near your home or even on your property. This testing will help to determine if groundwater and/or rainwater is entering the sanitary sewer system.

In order to make this determination, trained professionals from Gateway Engineers will perform nighttime flow isolation testing in sanitary sewer manholes between the hours of **12:00 AM and 5:00 AM. Testing in proximity to your home is scheduled to occur within the next 45 days.**

You do not have to be home for the testing. All Gateway workers will be wearing high visibility clothing and will have identification on them. No requests should be made to enter your home at any time. Testing at each sanitary sewer manhole can range from a few minutes to 45 minutes.

This testing is being conducted to satisfy requirements to a Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) Administrative Consent Order. Should you have any questions or require further information, please contact:
