

Becoming a Library Volunteer

A Road Map for Kids Going Into 6th-12th Grades



Ready, Set, Go!

Beginning in June, any student interested in volunteering must register for Teen Read—our summer library program for kids going into 6th-12th grades.



Stop 1: The Library

Sign up for Teen Read and begin reading books you've checked out from the Library. *All Teen Read participants who want to volunteer are required to read and report on at least 5 books by the end of Teen Read!*



Rest Area!

Have you finished a book? Fill out a blue or yellow book questionnaire form at the Library, letting us know about what you've read! *These forms go into a raffle for a prize drawing at the end of Teen Read, and help you reach your final destination of becoming a library volunteer.*



You Made It!

At the end of Teen Read, all participants who have successfully completed the requirements will be eligible for volunteer hours throughout the school year.

Hours for general library volunteering are given out on a monthly basis. Additional opportunities such as Readers Theater, book shelving, Friends of the Library book collections, book posters and display case are announced as they come up!



Pull Over!

Teen Read participants/volunteers who fail to read and report on at least 5 books by the end of the program will not be eligible for volunteer hours at the Library, and will forfeit (lose) any hours performed during Summer Reading.



Readers At Work!

Teen Read participants who are going into 7th-12th grades will be given volunteer opportunities during Summer Reading. They can help with programs for younger kids who are participating in Reading Together and Kids Read.
