

## COMPUTER/INTERNET POLICY

The Children's Internet Protection Act is a federal law that requires all computers in a public library to be filtered if that library accepts federal funds for Internet access. All computers in our library are filtered.

As with other materials, restriction of a minor's access to the Internet is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.

Not all sources on the Internet provide accurate, complete, or current information. The USC Township Library disclaims any liability or responsibility that arises from access to or use of information obtained through its electronic information systems or any consequences thereof.

Please note:

- A current library card in good standing is required to access the computers.
- A time limit of one hour will be imposed when patrons are waiting for an available station.
- Computers on the Children's floor are for the use of children and their families.
- Children under the age of 13 are to use the Internet stations on the children's floor with the supervision of their parents or guardians.
- Accessing/displaying sexually explicit materials that are offensive to accepted standards of decency or modesty is prohibited by law.  
(18 PA Cons. Stat. Sec 5903)
- Use of personal software is prohibited.  
Documents may not be saved to the hard drive.  
The CD Rom drive is read-only.  
Flash drives can be purchased at the Help Desk for \$10.
- Printing costs are 15 cents for black and white prints and 50 cents for color prints to be paid in advance. The Library does not refund money for unwanted print jobs on Library supplied paper.

Failure to comply with these stated rules will result in removal from the building and loss of library privileges.
