
# Why Automated Curbside Recycling?

- Larger single bin. Available in a 65 gallon bin; or for the super recycler, call and request a 96 gallon bin.
- Promotes increased stream of recycling materials.
- Recycling reduces items to the landfill, thus reducing trash disposal costs.
- No more need to cut or tear cardboard...just fit it in the bin!
- Safer for waste hauler employees.
- Demonstrates and promotes sustainable practices.
- Still a single stream service; all recyclables go into one bin.
- No need to carry your bin...just wheel it to the curb!



## RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING COLLECTION

- Aluminum, Bi-metal, Steel Food Cans
- #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, and #7 Plastics – NO STYROFOAM
- Clear, Green, and Brown Glass Containers
- Newsprint
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, etc.
- Cardboard and cardboard boxes – just fit it in the bin!
- Paperboard Boxes
- White Office Paper
- Computer Paper
- Magazines, Advertising Inserts, Junk Mail  
Envelopes, Catalogs, Phone Books,  
Paperback Books, Coupons / Receipts
- Paper Bags



Minimum 3' clear distance from other obstructions, such as cars, trash receptacles, trees, or mailbox.
