Baker Little Baseball Field has a few more renovations. The wire mesh still needs to be installed and the 3rd base area needs to be graded for proper drainage. The Bocce wood boards are being replaced and a skim coat of Har-Tru surface is being installed. The tennis/pickleball sliding gate will be adjusted by the fence contractor. Basketball/pickleball court improvements are completed. Currently, a 'bring your own pickleball net' is in place at the basketball courts. In addition, there is a potential vendor for the pole padding. All court lights have been painted, trash/recycling receptacles are to be installed and two (2) new water fountains will replace the two (2) existing ones.

Trotwood Park will have two (2) pickleball court lines in the coming weeks.

Boyce Mayview Softball and Baseball Fields repairs are to be completed in November. The canopy at the concession stand will be removed until Spring.

The Miracle Field/Clubhouse is looking to install a pavilion in 2017.

Portions of fence at Marmion Field will be repaired over winter. The field renovations are complete.

Gilfillan Park property survey is 90% complete. Boundary markers have been installed to identify the boundary to park patrons and adjacent property owners.

Water/splash pads will be turned off soon.

NEW BUSINESS

The Scary Swim event at the Community & Recreation Center (C&RC) was canceled due to power loss in the building. There will not be a makeup date.

One (1) stairmill and one (1) treadmill are currently broken at the C&RC. Service techs have been called, but due to the limited amount of techs in the area, the wait time is longer than normal.

It was commented that the paddle tennis courts look great.

Discussion regarding running water for gardeners at the Boyce Gardens took place.
