

Driver Education

This 30-hour theory course is required along with 6 hours of on-the-road driving experience for the benefit of insurance reduction. To participate in the classroom theory course, the student does not have to be 16 years of age and does not need to have a learner's permit.

Once the student is 16 years of age and obtains a PA learner's permit, he or she may call to schedule the 6 hours of on-the-road driving instruction (given in four 90-minute appointments to total 6 hours). These lessons would need to be scheduled and then paid for at the time the lessons are given.

Heartsaver Family and Friends

The Heartsaver Family and Friends course is meant for the lay public. There are three different Family and Friends courses offered and each module is scheduled for two hours. Each student receives the Family and Friends booklet and a course attendance card. There is no age requirement, prerequisite or test.

Heartsaver CPR

The Heartsaver CPR course is meant for the **lay public** who wish to earn a two year credentialed card. A skills performance is required to earn a card. Students receive a pocket mask with their materials.

Heartsaver AED (*with Child CPR/AED and Infant CPR*)

The Heartsaver AED course is designed for anyone who wants to earn a credentialed card in the use of an AED and those who have an AED at their place of business. A skills performance is required to earn a card. Each student will receive a textbook and pocket mask to keep.

Healthcare Provider

CPR for the healthcare professional is designed for and limited to professional rescuers and healthcare providers. This includes physicians, nurses, paramedics, etc. The course includes adult, child and infant CPR, use of AED, pocket mask and bag-valve mask device and two rescuer CPR. Skills performance and a written exam are required so that students may earn a credentialed card. The textbook is also required.

Heartsaver First Aid

This course teaches CPR, AED and first aid and offers a 2 year credentialed card. A text book and pocket mask are included. A skills performance is required to earn the card.
