UPPER ST. CLAIR, PA –In September, the Upper St. Clair Board of Commissioners passed an ordinance to allow controlled archery deer hunting on the Township's Boyce/Mayview Park property. A petition to repeal that ordinance is currently being circulated within the Township. The Township wants to inform residents of the intended purpose of the petition in order to avoid confusion.

If the Petitioners' Committee is able to get 2166 signatures of qualified Township electors, Ordinance No. 1780, which states, "No person shall engage in hunting and trapping of any type of animal or game on property owned or leased by the Township except by special permit for hunting only authorized by the Township Manager", will be suspended and a referendum will be placed on the election ballot in May 1999 for the voters of Upper St. Clair to consider the repeal of this ordinance.
