ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 5th day of March 2024, upon consideration of the Petition for Corrective Adjustments in Ward 3-2 and Ward 3-3, it is ORDERED and DECREED, that:

1. A Hearing is scheduled for the 18th day of March 2024 at 8:45a.m., before Judge John T. McVay, Jr., in courtroom 709, in the City-County Building, 414 Grant Street, 15219.
2. The Petition is referred to the Allegheny County Board of Elections, which shall make and report its findings and recommendations to me prior to the hearing; and
3. The Allegheny County Division of Elections shall provide notice as required by the Pennsylvania Elections Code.
4. The Allegheny County Board of Elections shall complete the reapportionment process as required by law.

Initially, it must be emphasized that filing a document with the Department of Court Records (“DCR”) is NOT notice to anyone. All filings should be docketed with the DCR, and then served on the opposing party, AND emailed to the judicial staff at evolz@alleghencourts.us and amcvay@alleghencourts.us. The DCR does NOT independently notice judges or parties when something is filed. Please do not mail anything to Judge McVay’s chambers unless it is the only means of providing Judge McVay with a copy.

Additionally, all parties are to review Judge McVay’s Operating Procedures that are located on the Fifth Judicial District’s Website.
